At approximately 0930 hours, I spoke with regarding the missing set of keys. He stated that key rings for the residence halls are created for the summer clean-up.

also stated that replacement locks would need to be ordered from the manufacturer and would be done on its own manufacturing run. also gave me a copy of the Key Control Policy and Procedures issued with the keys.

At 1220 hours, I met with in her office regarding some additional questions. I asked which door she opened for and she responded "I can't remember". I stated that if she opened the room for him, she would know the area in the building where the room was located. thought for a minute and then stated that had called her while she was in and she brought the keys to him at the front door of . After their lunch break, she asked for the keys back so she could unlock another room. stated that he gave them back to her before lunch.

She further stated that she left them there for her , to use during her shift. night time counterpart, the keys in the same place when she supervised cleanup last year. I asked if she still had the keys or knew if somebody else had them; she emphatically stated that she didn't and did not know if anybody else had them. She did not want to lose her job over a set of keys. I asked if she knew how much it would cost to replace the keys; she did not.
